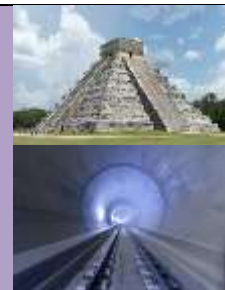

The Grand Egyptian Museum

1) The oldest museum in Cairo opened in 1835. There were more than 160,000 of Egypt's most valuable treasures on display. However, the museum did not have space for 100,000 other objects. In 2002, there was a competition to design a bigger and more modern museum. The competition had 1,557 designs from more than 80 different countries.

2) The Grand Egyptian Museum (**GEM**) welcomed its first visitors in 2019. It is further from the city centre than the old museum, but only two kilometres from the pyramids at Giza. It has more space for valuable objects more people can see them and it is able to look after the objects really well.

3) One of the most beautiful parts of the museum is the entrance with its big plants and statues. The biggest is that of Ramses 11, which is 12-metres high.

4) Moving these objects from the old museum in Tahrir to complete the Grand Egyptian Museum is not easy. It is expected to take many years of hard work .

The British Museum

The British Museum in London is the oldest public museum in the world. It opened in 1759 and now has more than 13 million objects. About six million visitors go there every year.

The museum has the biggest **collection** of Egyptian objects outside Egypt. One of its most important objects is the Rosetta Stone. This arrived at the museum in 1802. The writing on the stone is in three different languages. This allowed people to understand ancient Egyptian **hieroglyphics** for the first time. In my opinion, the most beautiful part of the museum is the Great Court. Its big glass room makes it the largest covered square in **Europe**. It opened in 2000, so it is also the most modern part of the museum.

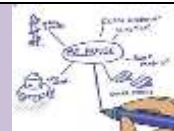
